

Church Weekend Frequently Asked Questions

Q. Will there be supper on Friday evening? Friday night there will be toast and cheese available as supper from 9pm onwards. There is no evening meal provided on the Friday.

Q. What will the supper be on Saturday evening? On Saturday evening a light supper will be provided c, 9.30pm. Cheese and toast, traybakes, nibbles tea, coffee

Q. Do I need to bring towels, bedding etc? No, Towels and bed linen will be provided.

Q. What are the rooms like? All rooms are en suite (except for one). For families they may be a bit cramped, so Stephen will ask you if you are willing to take two rooms.

Q. What is being arranged for the children? A range of activities are being put in place over the weekend and you will be given an activity schedule. However we would remind you that the children are your responsibility at all times. Please bring welly boots, hats, coats and gloves as there are some out door activities planned.

Q. What time can I arrive at? Any time you want. You will be allocated to a room and the key along with a letter will be available from reception on arrival. There will also be a floor plan which will show you where your room is.

Q. How do I find Dromantine? We will email simple directions to you prior to the weekend.

Q. Am I free to do my own thing? Yes. There is a programme, but Dromantine is that large (set in over 300 acres) please feel free to come and go as you please. There is a prayer room available. There is also a pathway in the grounds of Dromantine which has various depictions of the situations of the cross. There is also The Carroll room where you are free to sit and chill out.

Q. Can I heat my baby's food? Yes in The Coffee Dock there are full facilities to heat baby food. There will also be tea, coffee and toast should you get the nibbles. Some breakfast cereals will also be available just in case the children get you up very early, you can get a lite snack prior to breakfast at 9am.

Q. When do I need to pay? As soon as possible. Cheques payable to Christchurch Belfast.

Q. What if I am struggling to pay? Speak to one of the Elders in confidence and help can be arranged.

Q. Do I need cots or high chairs for the children? Speak to Stephen and he can arrange these if required.

Q. What's the food like? The menu we have chosen for your group is - **Saturday lunch:-** Chicken Breast, 2 Veg & Potato + Dessert with T/C. **Sat Evening Supper:-** Lasange coleslaw & chips with T/C. **Sunday lunch:-** R.Beef with 2 veg & potato + dessert with T/C. There will also be a children's menu available for all meals e.g Chicken Nuggets/Sausages/Chips etc. **Breakfast** consists of a selection of cereal, toast, boiled eggs, fresh fruit and yoghurts. Also wheaten breads, jams, grapefruit and orange vsegments.
